Homework

Every week, students will be given a brightly colored homework packet. Each packet is comprised of: reading logs and math work. Students need to complete all components of the packet and turn it in every Friday. Math work are spiral reviews.

Reading

Students are expected to read for at least 30 minutes per night. As the year progresses, we will try to increase our reading stamina. Students have simple reading logs to fill in Monday through Thursday; they are due every Friday.

Math

Students receive 4-5 math sheets per week, targeting specific skills. These packets are spiral reviews to practice what they have already learned.
