We Are Learning

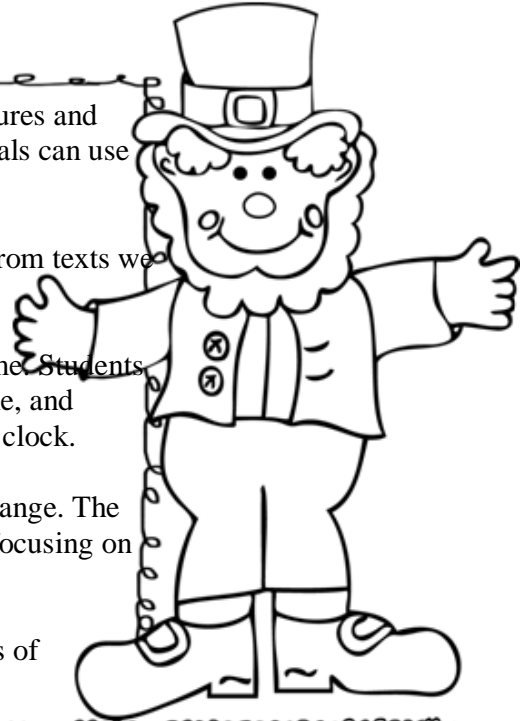
Reading- We will finish up learning about non fiction features and continue onto chapter 5. This unit focuses on how individuals can use their voices to respond to or create change.

Writing- Students will model and craft writing examples from texts we read in class.

Math- We will begin chapter 7, focusing on money and time. Students will be able to understand the value of a penny, nickel, dime, and quarter. Students will also be able to tell time on an analog clock.

Science-We will continue to learn about how landforms change. The students will also work on an interactive research project, focusing on the landform they choose.
